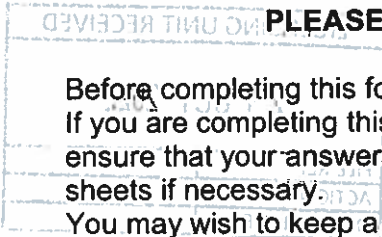

The Licensing Team, in conjunction with the Police Licensing Officer, has attempted to work with the Licence Holder to resolve problems identified at the premises in relation to noise and anti-social behaviour.

In accordance with our graduated approach to enforcement, we have advised the licence holder on several occasions of our concerns about the problems identified and the need for improvement. We have provided advice and guidance to the licence holder of the steps they need to take to address those concerns.

However, we have continued to receive complaints about the premises and have obtained evidence of breaches to licence conditions in relation to the following licensing objectives

The Licensing Authority has, therefore, decided to escalate the enforcement process and applied for a review of the premises licence.
